3. **Programme:**

Council Joint Action 2008/124/CFSP of 4.2.2008, on EULEX Kosovo as amended by JA 2009/445/CFSP and by Council Decision 2010/322/CFSP.

4. Financing:

Contract No CFSP/2012/9/EULEX Kosovo — Bout de Marnhac. This tender procedure will be launched under suspensive clause i.e. provision of the services concerned is subject to availability of the budget funds.

5. **Contracting authority:**

The Head of EULEX Kosovo, Pristina, KOSOVO.

6. Nature of contract:

Global price.

7. Contract description:

The purpose of this framework contract is provision of a cost-effective third part liability and comprehensive insurance coverage for EULEX Kosovo's entire fleet of vehicles within Kosovo, and international third party liability as well as international comprehensive insurance coverage for part of the abovementioned fleet.

8. Numbers and titles of lots:

The contract is divided into lots: No, 1 lot only.

9. **Budget:**

Maximum budget: 1 150 000 EUR.

10. Scope for additional services:

The contracting authority may, at its own discretion, extend the project in duration and/or scope, subject to the availability of funding, up to a maximum not exceeding the length and value of the initial contract. Any extension of the contract would be subject to satisfactory performance by the contractor.

Conditions of participation

11. Eligibility:

Participation in tendering is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union, in an official candidate country or a country that is a beneficiary of the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance, in a Member

State of the European Economic Area, a country of the western Balkans region or a contributing third State, as authorised by Council Joint Action 2008/124/CFSP of 4.2.2008 on EULEX Kosovo.

12. Candidature:

All eligible natural and legal persons (as per item 11 above) or groupings of such persons (consortia) may apply.

A consortium may be a permanent, legally-established grouping or a grouping which has been constituted informally for a specific tender procedure. All members of a consortium (i.e., the leader and all other members) are jointly and severally liable to the contracting authority.

The participation of an ineligible natural or legal person (as per item 11) will result in the automatic exclusion of that person. In particular, if that ineligible person belongs to a consortium, the whole consortium will be excluded.

13. Number of applications:

No more than 1 application can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting an application). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than 1 application, all applications in which that person has participated will be excluded.

14. Shortlist alliances prohibited:

Any tenders received from tenderers having a different composition than the ones on the application forms will be excluded from this restricted tender procedure, unless prior approval from the contracting authority has been obtained — see PRAG 2.4.3. Shortlisted candidates may not form alliances or subcontract to each other for the contract in question.

15. Grounds for exclusion:

As part of the application form, candidates must submit a signed declaration, included in the standard application form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3 of the 'Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions'.

16. **Subcontracting:**

Subcontracting is allowed.

Maximum percentage of the contract value which may be subcontracted: 30 %.

17. Number of candidates to be shortlisted:

On the basis of the applications received, at least 4 and at most 8 candidates will be invited to submit detailed tenders for this contract. If the number of eligible candidates meeting the selection criteria is less than the minimum of 4, the contracting authority may invite the candidates who satisfy the criteria to submit a tender.

Selection and award criteria

21. Selection criteria:

Same criteria for legal and natural person.

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

1) Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

In the case of the applicant being a public body equivalent information should be provided:

- 1. total average annual turnover of candidate(s) must be at least equal to the maximum budget of the contract for the last 3 years (2009, 2010 and 2011);
- 2. the candidate has been operational for the last 4 years (2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011).
- 2) Professional capacity of candidate:
- 1. at least 8 staff currently work for the applicant in fields related to this contract; where at least 2 of them are qualified technical experts with a communicative level of English language;
- 2. at least 50 % of all staff working for the candidate this year in fields related to this contract are permanent.
- 3) Technical capacity of candidate:
- 1. candidate(s) have (all) worked on at least 1 major project similar to this in fields related to transport fleet insurance in the past 3 years, meaning candidate(s) have (all) provided the services mentioned in the 'contract description' as outlined in point 7 above, in the past 4 years (2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011).

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. Some examples of when it may not be considered appropriate by the contracting authority are when the tenderers rely in majority on the capacities of other entities or when they rely on key criteria. If the candidate relies on other entities it must in that case prove to the contracting authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator. Furthermore, the data for this third entity for the relevant selection criterion should be included in the tender in a separate document. Proof of the capacity will also have to be furnished when requested by the contracting authority.

If more than 8 eligible candidates meet the above selection criteria, the relative strengths and weaknesses of the applications of these candidates must be re-examined to identify the 8 best applications for the tender procedure. The only factors which will be taken into consideration during this re-examination are:

- 1. the number of projects related to this contract completed in the last 3 years;
- 2. in the case of equal number of projects, the total amount (in euros) of the projects completed in the last 3 years.

30. Additional information:

The contracting authority may, at its own discretion, extend the contract in duration up to further 12 months by amendment to the present contract signed by both parties. Such an amendment shall be subject to a negotiated procedure according to 3.2.3.1 of the 'Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions'. Please note that the awarding of the contract is subject to the condition of the prior adoption of a financing decision and the prior conclusion of a financing agreement, which do not modify the elements of the procurement procedure (this will be the case, for instance, if the budgetary envelope initially foreseen is different or if the time-frame, the nature or the condition of the implementation are altered).

If the precedent condition is not met, the contracting authority will either abandon the procurement or cancel the award procedure without the candidates' or tenderers' being entitled to claim any compensation.
